

FISHING RESULTS:

69 Walleye - 34 Pike

Saturday, August 6th from 2:00 pm until 5 pm; 10 Walleye and 5 Pike. Sunday from 9:00 am until 11:30 am; 12 Walleye and 9 Pike. Monday 10:00 am until 1:00 pm; 5 Walleye and 2 Pike, 3 more Walleye in an hour that evening. Tuesday 7:00 am until 1:30 pm; 15 Walleye and 7 Pike (1 of each in D'Arcy Lake, the rest by the cabins) 4:30 pm until 6:15 pm by the cabins; 7 Walleye and 5 Pike. Wednesday (rain all morning) 1:30 pm until 5:30 pm; 9 Walleye and 1 Pike. Thursday 7:30 am until 9:30 am; 4 Walleye, later from 12 noon until 1:30 pm 2 Pike and then from 6:00 pm until 6:30 pm 2 more Walleye. Friday from 7:00 am until 10:00 am 2 Walleye and 3 Pike. Heavy rain and hail about 1:00 pm.
